HALESOWEN GOLF CLUB LOCAL RULES

- A Ball lying in a drainage ditch/trench, a grooved marked line, any artificially surfaced path and steps or any tyre mark may be lifted and dropped, without penalty, within one club-length of the nearest point of relief, not nearer the hole.
- SPRINKLER HEADS** – Where a sprinkler head is within two club-lengths of the green and within two club-lengths of the ball (The ball is not in a hazard) and directly on the line between the ball and the hole then the player may take relief under Rule 24-2.
- When playing the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 17th and 18th holes and a ball is lying on the road or if the road interferes with the player's stance or his area of intended swing. The ball may be marked, lifted and then dropped without penalty within one club-length of and not nearer the hole at the nearest point of relief.
- There are three **Designated Dropping Zones** as follows:
 - a) On the 5th fairway for use if the ball comes to rest **ON** or within one club-length of the edge of the 12th green.
 - b) The back of the 4th green, use if the ball comes to rest **ON** or within one club-length of the edge of the 4th green, when playing the 3rd hole.
 - c) On the 11th fairway for use if the ball comes to rest **ON** or within one club-length of the edge of the 11th winter green.
- Balls **MUST** be lifted and dropped if it is **ON** a temporary green or if it is **ON** a wrong green (apart from the above mentioned greens).
- A ball is out of bounds if:-
 - a) It lies in or outside any ditch, fence, stakes or trees marking the boundary of the course.
 - b) When playing the 14th or 16th holes it lies on or over the road.
 - c) It lies over the kerbstone or markers beyond the 18th green.
- If a ball strikes a telephone wire or post, electric cable or post, or a marker post another ball **MUST** be played without penalty.
- Bunker relief, after heavy rain, free relief may be taken **within** the bunker from any storm damage, i.e. water valleys, caused by the shear volume of water passing through a bunker, the ball may be dropped within one clubs length of the nearest point of relief.
- If a staked tree, interferes with a stance or swing. The ball must be lifted and dropped within one club-length of the nearest point of relief.
- A Ball lying on a Mole Hill or the remnants of a Mole Hill may be, marked lifted and dropped without penalty – Rule 25.1 applies.
